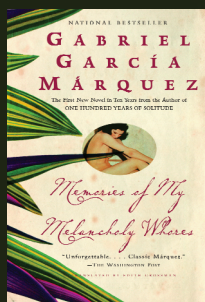

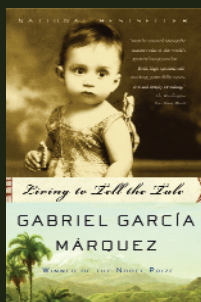

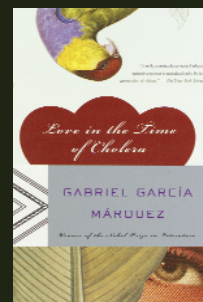

is Andrew W. Mellon Professor Emeritus of Modern Languages at the University of Pittsburgh and Senior Research Professor in Caribbean Studies at London Metropolitan University. For twenty-five years he has been the only English-speaking member of the Archive of Twentieth-Century Latin American Literature in Paris, and he is a recent president of the International Institute of Ibero-American Literature in the United States. Among his publications are *Journeys Through the Labyrinth: Latin American Fiction in the Twentieth Century* and several contributions to the *Cambridge History of Latin America*. He lives in England.
