From March 2007 through August 2008, he served as Economic Counselor and Director of Research at the International Monetary Fund, gaining further experience in managing economic crises. Johnson holds a Ph.D. in economics from MIT, an M.A. from the University of Manchester and a B.A. from the University of Oxford.

Kwak was also co-founder and Vice President of Marketing at Guidewire Software, Inc., an independent software vendor in the property and casualty insurance industry. He was a consultant for McKinsey & Co., a leading global management consulting firm. He is currently a student in the class of 2011 at Yale Law School. Kwak holds a Ph.D. in history from the University of California, Berkeley and an A.B. from Harvard University.
